IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

1. **Projects-** Your child will several “at home projects,” that will count towards their social studies and writing grades. These projects allow families to work together while learning at the same time. Projects include- “All About Me,” “African-American and Women History projects.
 2. **Communication Folders-** Your child will have a folder that will come home daily. This folder will have their homework, any communication from the teachers, and a behavior calendar. **Please note-** These folders are not checked by the teachers. Each student is responsible for putting their homework in the folder and for turning in any notes you send to their homeroom teacher.
 3. **ATTENDANCE/LATENESS-** School starts at 9:00 am. Attendance is very important. In the case they are absent please send in a doctor’s note or get an absence form from the office to excuse the absence. We eat breakfast from 8:30 AM-8:45 AM in our cafeteria. If your child comes after 9:00 they will not be able to eat breakfast as we have begun instruction and food has been collected. Our lunch time is 11:45-12:30 pm.
 4. **DOJO-** Please join and check dojo often. We will send a lot of information on there and it is a great way for us to keep you updated on your student. On dojo you are able to message both teachers.
